



Are you interested in obtaining training to help you become employed in the environmental/green job industry?

The Miami Brownfield Job Training Program is available to City of Miami residents free of charge. The purpose of the program is to provide residents with the opportunity to obtain skills that will increase employability within environmental/green industry careers pertaining to work that affects our everyday livelihood. Within the program, you will learn about protecting the environment, responding to hazardous emergency situations, investigating contaminated property, applying technologies for cleanup of contamination, and property redevelopment. The next class cycle will begin in February 2011. Each class cycle is held for 2 ½ months. If interested, you must be flexible to attend class each day. Class times vary weekly and could start from 8:00 am and last until 5:00 pm or shorter. Some courses last the entire week (Monday thru Friday). An example of courses with certifications offered includes;

- Health and Safety/First Aid CPR
- Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response
- Phase I and Phase II Sampling Procedures
- Brownfields 101
- Asbestos Abatement
- Heavy Equipment Operation
-And other green industry related subjects

The basic entry requirements will be;

- City of Miami Residency (within the jurisdiction and City limits of Miami- visit <http://egov.ci.miami.fl.us/addresscheck/> to verify)
- 18 years and older
- Score at least a 9th grade level on the Adult Basic Education Skills Test (TABE)
- High School Diploma or GED (will verify)
- Ability to pass physical and drug test
- Background Check to demonstrate employability
